5. Your country, or the country to which the items are destined, holds no import restrictions on the goods that you wish to purchase.
6. The country has no import licence restrictions or a restriction on currency allocation.
7. The country has no prolonged inspection procedure which might cause excessive delay in allowing your goods to be imported.
8. You receive a fully descriptive invoice in order that you may arrange payment as soon as possible with our bank, whose details are given earlier.
9. You employ a reputable freight forwarding organisation. Please note that many of the removal companies in this country are not necessarily freight forwarders.
